## EXPRESS YOURSELF WITH ART

This resource has been produced to creatively support children's move to secondary school.

Children can use highlighter pens, pencils, or felts for colouring in their artwork. Or they can mix them together. Remember there is no right or wrong way to do the artwork, just their own unique style.

## HOW TO USE THE RESOURCE

Our resident graffiti artists have created over 70 stunning pieces of graffiti artwork that can be used to explore a variety of themes related to children's move to secondary school. The artwork can be used in one-to-one sessions, small group work, the entire class, or creatively engage children as part of a transition taster event.

## For example:

- **Moving on** (artwork 1-23): Many children will have grown out of their primary school and will be excited about moving to secondary school, for some, it may be seen as a fresh start, whilst others may experience sadness or anxiety due to the uncertainty and change that comes with the transition.
- **My new school** (artwork 24-35): Use the artwork to explore and examine the excitement of new opportunities, subjects, teachers, and friendships, as well as potential worries that children may have about transitioning to secondary school.
- **Friendships** (artwork 36-57): During the transition to secondary school, friends are both a crucial protective factor and often a source of stress for children. While having friends is important, friendships tend to be fluid in nature, as new ones are formed and old ones are lost.
- **Emotional well-being** (artwork 57-74): It's crucial children prioritise their emotional well-being as they transition to secondary school. Including self-care techniques, such as ensuring they get the right amount of sleep or talking through any concerns they might have with friends, family or a trusted adult in school.





















































































































